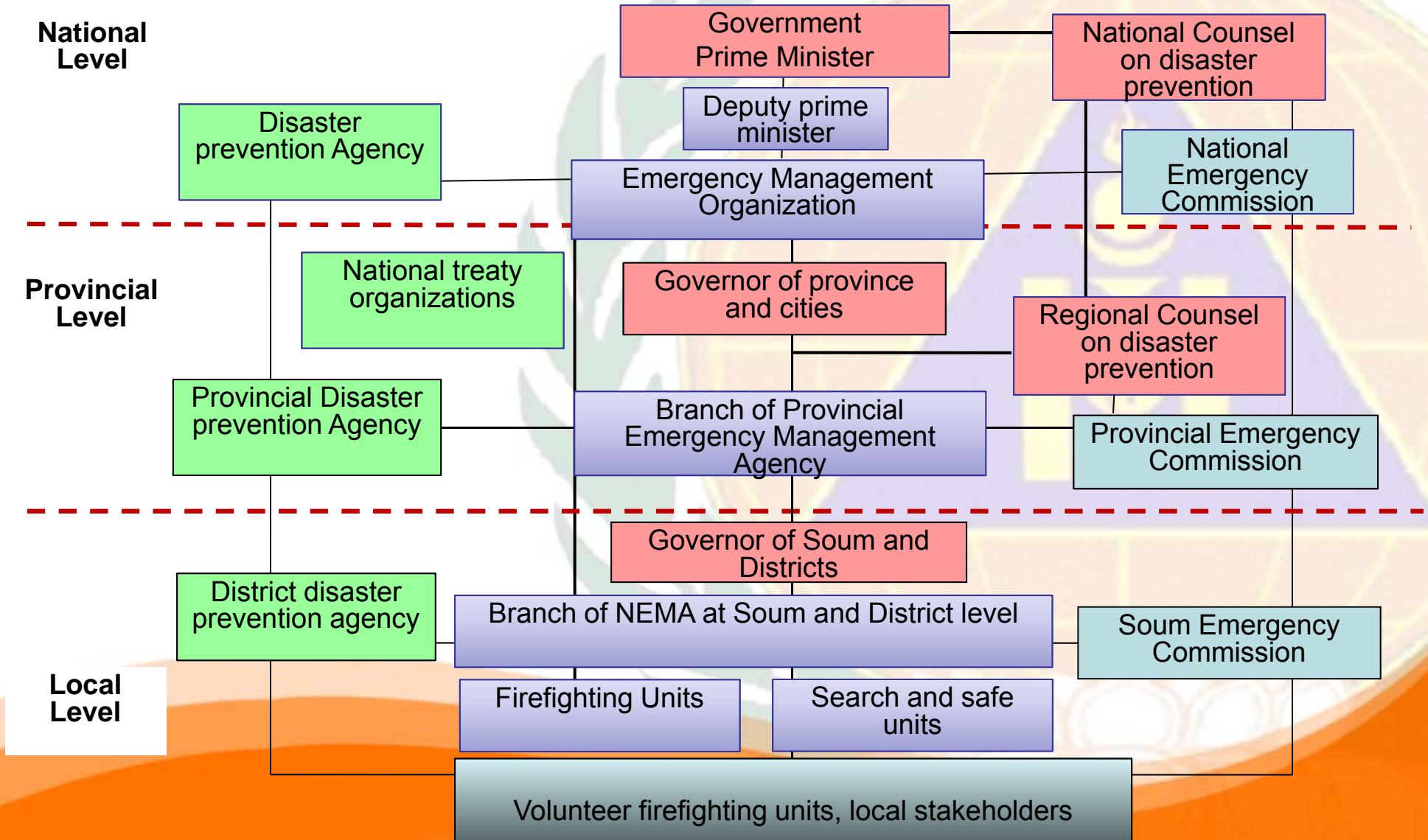

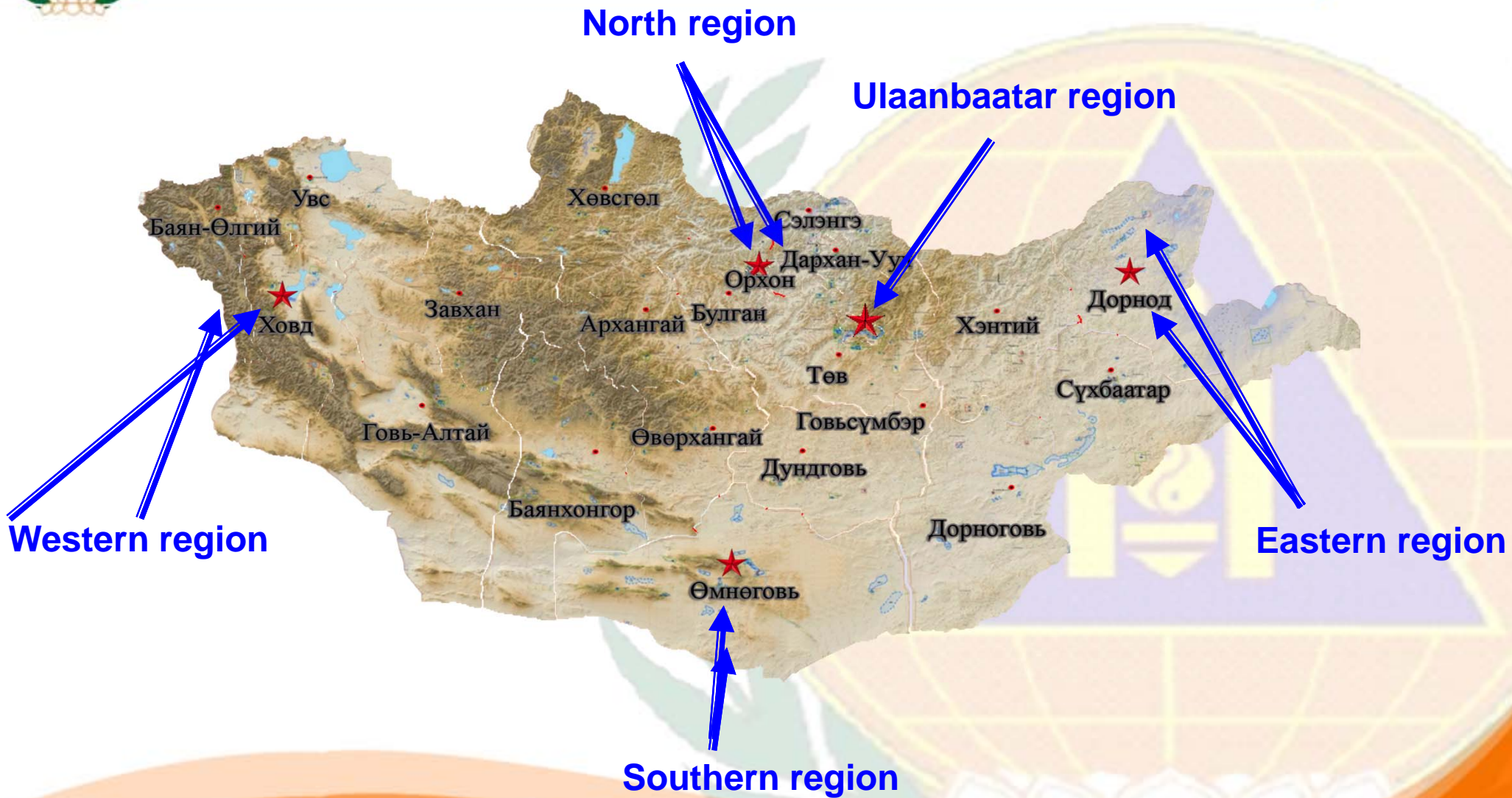

Cooperation of State security organizations on forest and steppe fire issues



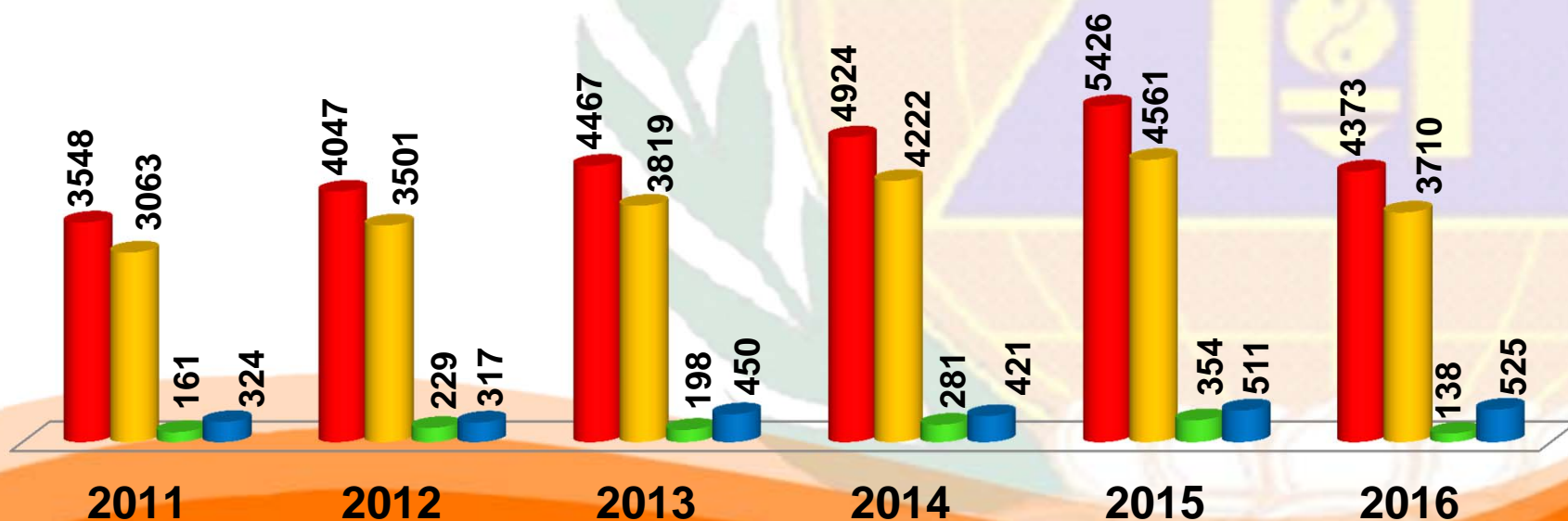
- General Plan of Cooperation during the Fire Emergency Situation: General Border Authority, Police Department, State Inspection Agency, other stakeholders /by Government decree/

Number of disaster incidents between 2011 and 2016 in Mongolia

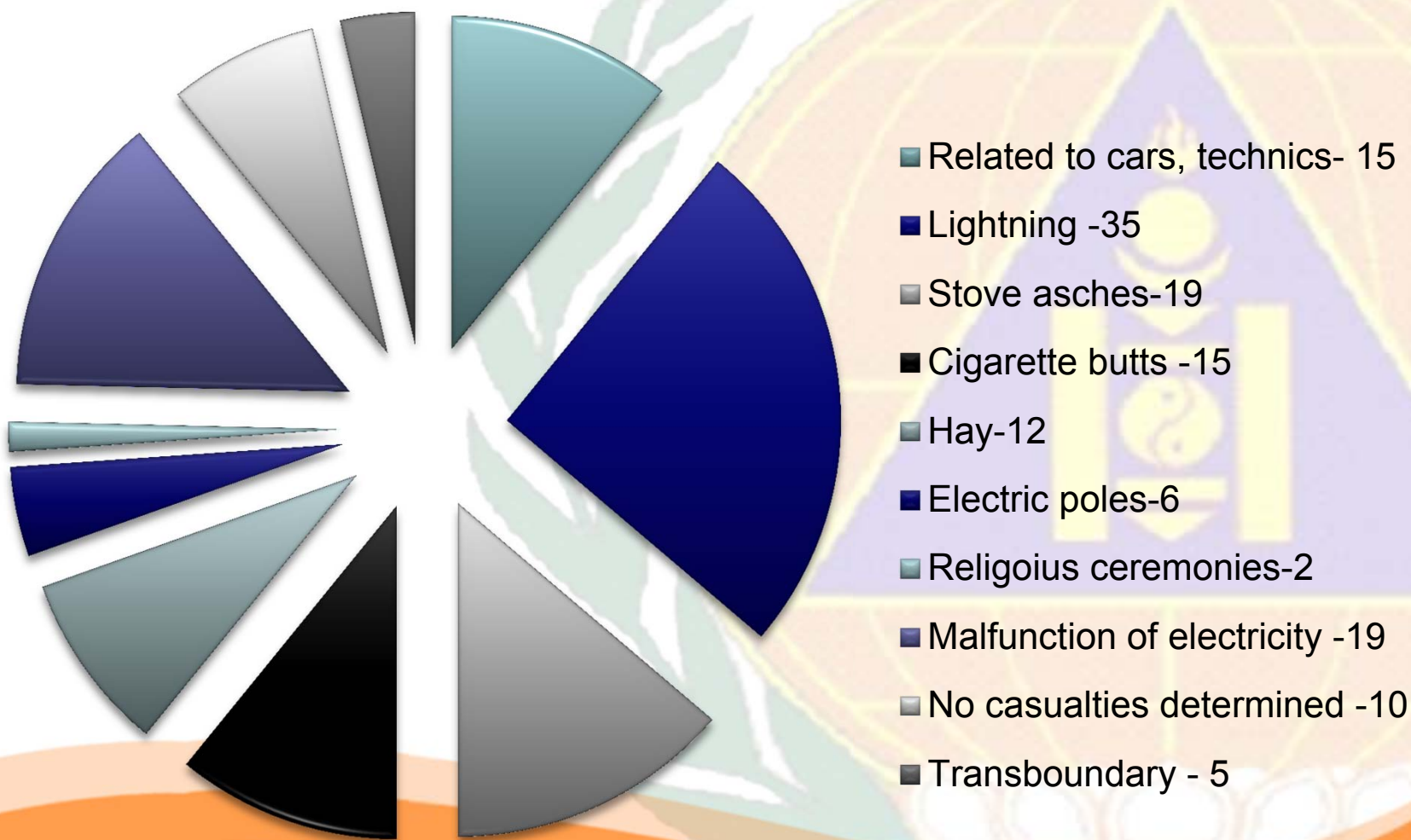

In 13 soums of 64 provinces 206 forest and steppe fires:

82,164.8 ha forest,

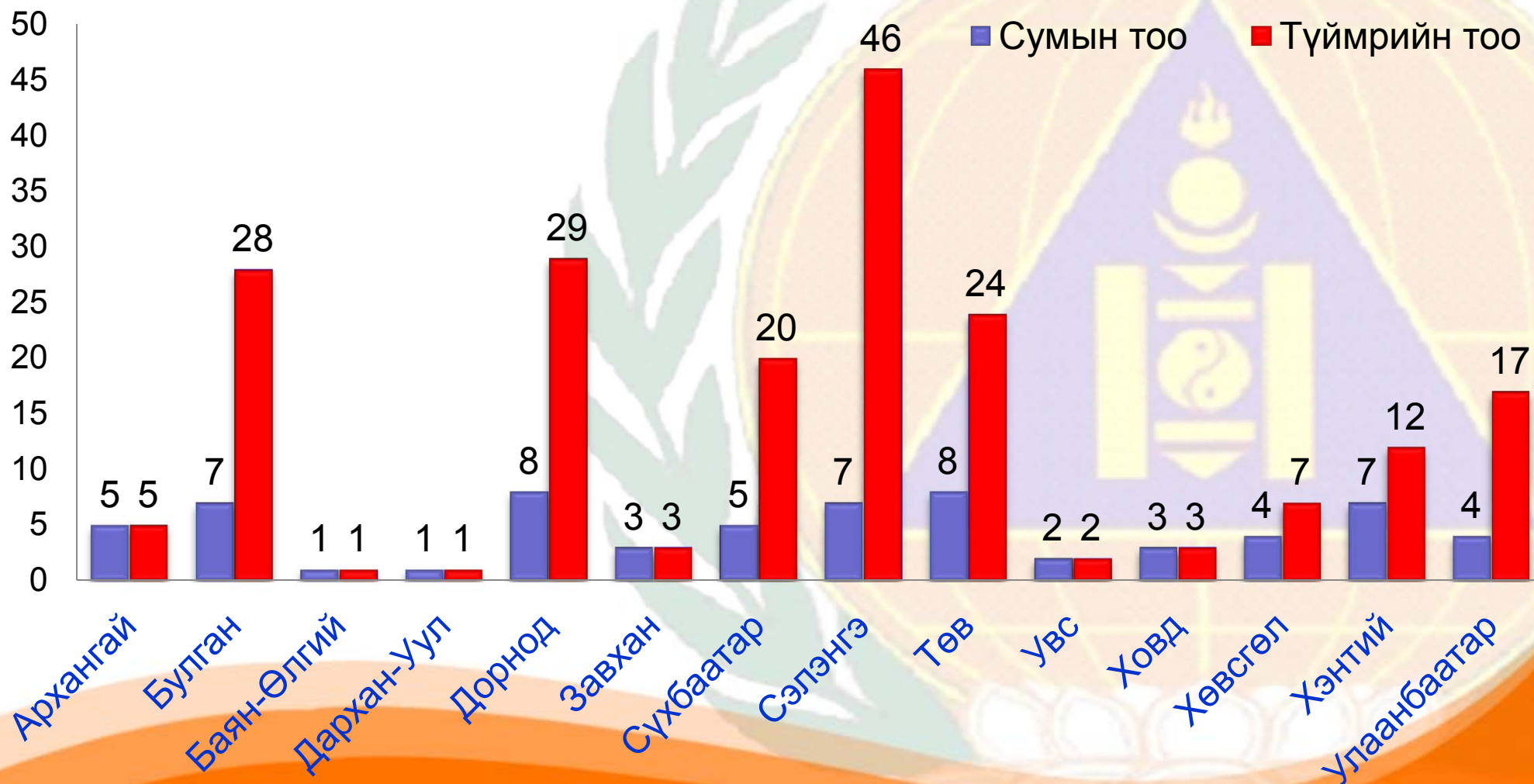
354,817.7 ha steppe

Total area: 436,982.5 ha

Around 9988 person, 1050 vehicles, 182 motorcycle, and 237 horses has been participated
